The Institute for Corruption Studies (ICS) at Illinois State University announces its 3rd workshop on corruption, to be held virtually on November 19-20, 2021. Papers on the following list of topics are particularly welcome:

- Regulations and corruption.
- Lobbying and regulations.
- Regulations and the shadow economy.
- Enforcement of regulations.

While the workshop theme is “Regulations and Corruption”, papers on any topic related to corruption are invited. The two-day workshop will serve as a forum to present current research and will give researchers the opportunity to network. As the workshop intends to build a network among the researchers who work on corruption, papers from all social science and legal disciplines are invited. Selected papers will be published in a special issue in *Public Finance Review* (after going through journal’s peer review process) guest edited by Oguzhan Dincer and Michael Johnston.
